

PROJECT: El Dorado and Gold Street Storm Sewer Improvement

General Description: The City of San Jose Department of Public Works has developed this project to adequately accommodate the volume of local storm water runoff. This will be accomplished by installing new storm pipelines, inlets, sidewalk, curb and gutter.

This project will construct approximately 1,725 linear feet of storm drain pipe and approximately 1,100 linear feet of sidewalk, curb and gutter.

Streets to be Impacted:

- Gold Street between Catherine Street and Elizabeth Street
- El Dorado Street between Elizabeth Street and Moffat Street
- The corner of Moffat Street and Gold Street.

Construction Cost: \$1,249,250


Schedule: Construction begins September 2012
