

PROJECT: Spreckles Force Main Supplement and Pump Rehabilitation

General Description: This project will rehabilitate the electrical and mechanical components of the existing Spreckles Sanitary Sewer Pump Station, in addition to the installation of a new secondary force main from the pump station to its discharge point at the San Jose / Santa Clara Water Pollution Control Plant (WPCP). This project was developed in response to frequent maintenance needs at this facility.

Since the conversion of the Spreckles site from a wastewater treatment facility to a sanitary sewer pump station in the 1970's, no major upgrades or renovations have been performed. The proposed improvements will reduce the on-going maintenance costs associated with this facility and provide reliable and continuous sewer service to the area. Upon completion of this project a second phase will rehabilitate the existing force main.

Streets to be Impacted:

- Spreckles Avenue and Grand Boulevard
- Grand Boulevard and Los Esteros Road


Spreckles Project - Rehabilitated pump station and new force main will prevent maintenance issues and disruption of service to the residents of the Alviso area
